# Who We Are



Nevo Parudimos is a non-governmental, civic and independent association from other state bodies, created by free choice and initiative of founding members in August 2008.

The youth activities are vast and offer a possibility for our youth to further develop and learn new things:


- Volunteering activities in Romania and abroad

# Location - Resita

Resita is a mountain town of about 73.000 people located in the south western part of Romania. 3 centuries ago, the first furnace was opened in the city, from then on Resita becoming a major industrial center all the way until today. Resita lays in the middle of Banat Mountains, so to live in Resita means having greenery and mountains in your sight at any time, while still enjoying the perks of urban life.

The reality in Resita is that when it comes to youth work and volunteering at the local level, we could do better. Motivation in youngsters is rather low, as volunteering is not considered a very pragmatic (or financially rewarding) occupation. That's why trough these 12 months we have high hopes that we can actually bring some change in the lives of the people in the community as well as the youngsters who drop off from school, people with disabilities and so on, motivate those who are willing to see change at local level, cooperate with the local youngsters and showing them our work.

# Activities

Volunteering within our project will consist in organizing non-formal, child-centered activities with the children and young people from the placement centers in Resita.

The activities in these centers will be organized daily and they will be educational and leisure activities organized using non-formal education methodology, designed to develop creativity, involvement, participation, tolerance and acceptance among young people as well as to develop communication skills, relationship and self esteem.



Beside these activities, the volunteers will organize activities aimed to involvement of local young people into social activities, to facilitate the interaction between the young people in the placement centers and locals.



Among these monthly activities, volunteers will prepare every month an activity that will have different themes and which, on the one hand, will promote the interaction between local young people, and also develop the spirit of volunteering, involvement, tolerance and understanding among young people.



## Accommodation

We provide accommodation in a full-equipped and furnished apartment - there are all the necessary conditions for a good life. Rent and utilities (water, gas, electricity) will be paid by the hosting NGO.

The volunteers will be accommodated in double bedrooms. The flat has its own bathroom and kitchen as well.


