OUR METHODS OF WORK



**VOLUNTEERS SHOULD EXPECT FLEXIBLE WORKING SCHEDULE;
UP TO 35 HOURS OF ENGAGEMENT PER WEEK, HOLIDAYS AND NEGOTIATED DAYS-OFF;
SUPERVISION IN WORKING TASKS AND BASIC TRAINING (+ ESC TRAINING CYCLE);
VARIOUS FORMATS OF ENGAGEMENT: ON-SITE, REMOTE, INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP WORK;
A LOT OF COLLABORATION WITH LOCAL PEOPLE;
USAGE OF DIGITAL COLLABORATION TOOLS E.G. ASANA, TRELLO, GCALENDAR;
ACTIVITIES ARE HELD IN VARIOUS LOCATIONS WHILE ENGAGING VARIOUS PARTNERS.**

ACCOMMODATION AND LOCATIONS

VOLUNTEERS (2-3) WILL LIVE TOGETHER SHARING ONE APARTMENT (IN SPERATE ROOMS) IN VINNYTSIA. IT IS A HALF A MILLION PEOPLE CITY, CAPITAL OF THE VINNYTSIA OBLAST. HERE VOLUNTEERS WILL MEET, PLAN, WORK ON CULTURAL CLUBS AND MEDIA PRODUCTION ETC. RURAL PROJECTS WILL BE REALIZED IN THE WIDER REGION AND ESPECIALLY IN A SMALL REMOTE BUT UNIQUE COMMUNITY OF THE STINA VILLAGE.
